

# Ornament 2010 for found objects

## Supplies needed:

- Light weight cardboard 4" X 4"
  - Fabric 5" X 5"
  - Tassel 1" to 2"
- Found object (old keys, watch parts and kind of trinkets)
  - Bits of feathers (for hair)
- Glue (ultimate is what I use but crafter's glue)
  - Paperclay (for head)
- And thin cording or heavy thread (for hanger)
  - Piece of felt that goes with fabric

I love making ornaments and this one is just the right size to add found objects to...

Cut out body from body template one cut from cardboard

One from felt (this is your backing)

Cut out fabric piece and make snips as shown no deeper than cardboard...

Smear glue on entire cardboard body lay fabric on top of glue press and smooth....then  
put glue around the edge of back of cardboard body and glue "tabs"

Using paperclay or other air dry clay...roll about 1" ball press in to palm of your hand,  
smooth out front side with a wet paint brush....let dry (you can dry on very low heat in  
the oven)

You can lightly sand if you like, this face can be painted with acrylics or left white

Using permanent pens draw face and use q-tip with a bit of lip stick or blush (rouge) then  
spray face with clear sealer the cheap kind works fine

Glue tassel to the bottom center of ornament, glue loop made from heavy thread or thin  
cording to back top center...smear glue over entire back and place felt "body" and let  
dry...now you can glue feathers behind the head and head to front of ornament...then  
embellish the front of body with found objects... I used an old key
